



Randolph L. "Randy" Laugle

November 4, 1944 - December 10, 2015

Randolph L. Laugle, age 71, of Huntington, died at 9:50 p.m. Thursday (December 10, 2015) at Visiting Nurse and Hospice Home in Fort Wayne.

Visitation will be from 2 - 8 p.m. Monday (December 14, 2015) at Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington, Indiana. Funeral services will be held at 11 a.m. Tuesday (December 15, 2015) at Bailey-Love Mortuary with Pastor Dennis Hardin officiating. There will be two hours of visitation prior to the service. Burial will be in Pilgrims Rest Cemetery in Huntington.

Randy was born on Nov. 4, 1944 in Cincinnati, Ohio, the son of Edward and Georgia (Sandlin) Laugle, and was raised by his grandparents Morris and Mary Sandlin. He graduated from Andrews High School in 1962 and married Karen Frederick on December 5, 1964 at Trinity United Methodist Church in Huntington, with Rev. Gary Forbes officiating. He retired as Operations Manager at United REMC (now Heartland) after 41 years of service. Randy was a member of Trinity United Methodist Church and Moose Lodge #837, both in Huntington.

Survivors include his wife of 51 years - Karen Laugle of Huntington; a daughter - Lori Coffelt of Columbia City; a son - Brian (Holly) Laugle of West Point, Kentucky; two sisters - Judy Hogan of Huntington and Sharon (Curt) Park of Fort Wayne; two brothers - Tom (Glenda) Laugle of Tustin Ranch, California and Carl Sandlin of Huntington; and seven grandchildren - Braden Coffelt, Colton Coffelt, Gillian Laugle, Corynne Laugle, Aiden Laugle, Grayson Laugle, and Gentry Laugle. He is preceded in death by his parents, grandparents, and a son-in-law - Joe Coffelt.

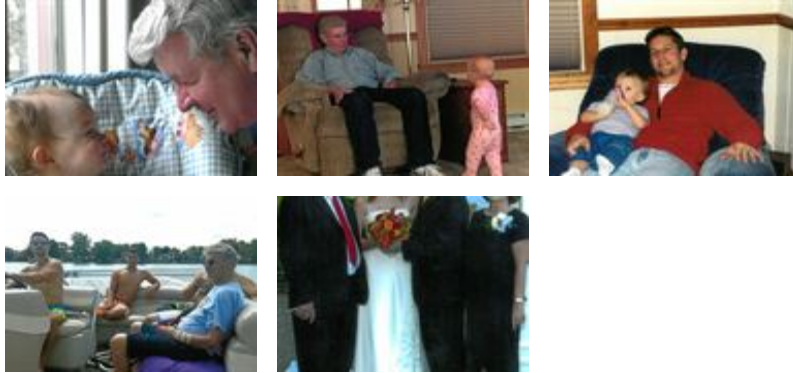
