Raymond C. Huffman, age 20, of Huntington, died at 12:05 a.m. on Thursday (January 21, 2010) from injuries sustained in an automobile accident in Wells County.

Raymond was born on September 5, 1989 in Bluffton, Indiana the son of Richard and Cheryl (Juergens) Huffman. He graduated from Huntington North High School in 2008 and was a full time student at Ivy Tech in Fort Wayne. Raymond worked for Papa John's Pizza in Huntington and Fort Wayne and also worked at the Kilsquah campground gate at the Huntington Reservoir in Huntington. Raymond attended Bethel Assembly of God in Huntington. He was a member of the Huntington Y.M.C.A., former member of the Huntington County Wrestling club, played football for Huntington North High School, and played Huntington County Baseball. Raymond also wrestled for Huntington North High School, where he went to semi-state.

Survivors include his parents – Richard and Cheryl Huffman of Huntington; two brothers – Joshua J. and Karl A. Huffman of Huntington; one sister – Megan E. Huffman of Huntington; grandparents – George (Judy) Juergens of Huntington, and Jim (Regina) Huffman of Petroleum, Indiana; one grandmother – Anna Huffman of Bluffton; one great-grandfather – Roger Huffman of Bluffton; two uncles – Dan (Gina) Juergens of Roanoke, and Michael (Cassy) Huffman of Bluffton; and two aunts – Kristina Loveday and

Diana Wolfe both of Bluffton. He is preceded in death by his grandmother – Nancy Juergens; great-grandparents – Harold and Helen Juergens; and great-grandmother – Ruby Huffman.

Visitation will be 3 - 7 p.m. Monday (January 25, 2010) at Bailey-Love Mortuary. Funeral services will be at 10 a.m. Tuesday (January 26, 2010) at Bethel Assembly of God, 1640 East Taylor Street, Huntington with Dr. John Backes officiating. Burial will be in the Woodlawn Cemetery, Warren, Indiana.

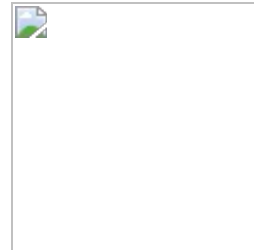

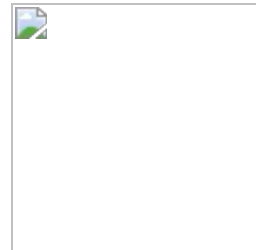

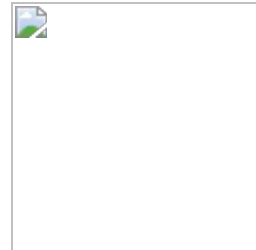
