



## Rebecca "Becky" A. Chenoweth

January 27, 1941 - March 14, 2023

Rebecca "Becky" A. Chenoweth, 82, of Huntington, passed away at 3:03 pm Tuesday, March 14, 2023, at Heritage Pointe of Huntington.

Rebecca "Becky" was born on January 27, 1941, in Marion, IN, the daughter of Raymond Foust and Georgia (Christman) Foust. She graduated from Jefferson High School with the class of 1960. Becky married the love of her life Paul Thomas Chenoweth on August 7, 1960, in Upland, IN. They shared 45 years of marriage before he preceded her in death on March 24, 2006.
