Rebecca Rae Taylor, age 69, of Huntington, passed away unexpectedly Friday, June 30, 2017 at her Huntington home. Becca was born September 1, 1947 in South Bend, Indiana to Rodney and Wilma (Thomas) Davenport. On January 7, 1967 she was married to Lynn E.
