May 30, 1944 - February 22, 2012

Rex B. Boyer, age 67, of Huntington, died at 6:47a.m. Wednesday, (February 22, 2012) at Parkview Huntington Hospital.

Rex was born May 30, 1944, in Huntington, to Roger and Nellie (Pasko) Boyer. He was a 1963 graduate of Lancaster High School, and completed 2 years at DeVry Tech in Chicago, Illinois. He was a Specialist 5 in the United States Army and a veteran of the Vietnam War. Rex married Glenda L. Jester on November 9, 1968 in Huntington, Indiana.

Rex was a farmer in the Lancaster Township area and retired from BAE Systems in Fort Wayne after 45 years of service. He was a member of the First Church of the Nazarene.

Rex is survived by his wife of 43years – Glenda L. Boyer of Huntington; son – Troy (Amanda) Boyer of Warren; two daughters – Tonya (Tony) Martin of Huntington and Tara (Jay) Buzzard of Warren; brother – Jack (Marquita) Boyer of Urbana, Ohio and 3 grandchildren – Chelsie Taylor, A.J. Martin and Nate Martin. His parents and sister, Joann Boyer preceded him in death.
