



Rex Allen LaVine

May 16, 1944 - May 26, 2011

Rex Allen LaVine, 67, of Huntington died at 8:02 p.m. Thursday (May 26, 2011) at his daughter's home in Roanoke.

Rex was born on May 16, 1944, in Huntington, to William Allen and Dorothy A. (Chesterman) LaVine. He was united in marriage to Jean Ann Gray on June 7, 1964 in Huntington.

Rex worked at the Parkview Huntington Hospital in housekeeping, Wabash Technologies, and the Noll Printing warehouse for 23 years. He also worked part time at the Huntington County Jail. He was a member of the Eagles Lodge #823, Moose Lodge #837, and the Sons of American Legion #85. He had volunteered for the former Red Cross (DAT) Disaster Action Team for many years. Rex loved to camp, go bowling, and watch his grandchildren's activities.

Survivors include his wife of 46 years - Jean Ann LaVine of Huntington; two daughters -Kimberly Ann (Mark) Criswell of Huntington and Kelly Joan (Patrick) Lee of Roanoke; one brother - David B. LaVine of Huntington; one sister - Ruth Ann LaDuke of Salem, Virginia, and six grandchildren - Justin Criswell, Allen Criswell, Brooke Criswell, Nathan Lee, Daniel Lee, and Matthew Lee. His parents and brother, William T. LaVine, preceded him in

death.
