Richard G. "Dick" Class, age 97, of Huntington, died at 1:55 p.m. Sunday (February 28, 2016) at his home.

Visitation will be from 10 a.m. - 12 p.m. Thursday (March 3, 2016) at Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington, Indiana. Funeral services will immediately follow at 12 p.m. Thursday at Bailey-Love Mortuary with Pastor Jeff Carrell officiating. Burial will be in Mt. Hope Cemetery in Huntington with military graveside rites performed by VFW Post #2689 of Huntington.

Dick was born on October 22, 1918 in Huntington, the son of William and Myrtle Class. He graduated from Huntington High School in 1936 and served in the United States Army for fourteen months during World War II, four months spent overseas. He was awarded a Purple Heart medal, Bronze Battle Star, Conflict Infantry Badge, a Victory Ribbon, and a Good Conduct Ribbon. He worked for Pennsylvania Railroad in Fort Wayne for 39 ½ years. Dick was a member of VFW Post #2689, American Legion Post #85, and Moose Lodge #823, all in Huntington. He loved fishing and was an avid card player.

Surviving are many cousins. His parents precede him in death.
