



## Richard E. Hefner

October 16, 1922 - May 23, 2010

Richard E. Hefner, age 87, of Huntington, died at 9:53 p.m. Saturday (May 22, 2010) at his home.

Richard was born October 16, 1922, the son of John and Faye (Andrew) Hefner, in Huntington. He graduated from Andrews High School in April 1941. He was a veteran of the United States Army during WW II from December 1942 to February 1946. Richard was a recipient of the Purple Heart.

Richard owned and operated a vending machine service for 32 years retiring in 1984. He serviced the northern Indiana area from 1952 – 1984. Richard was also employed by Huntington Lumber, Wayne Candies, and Maco. He was a lifetime member of the American Legion, V.F.W. Post #2689, and the Masonic Lodge #483 Amity Lodge. He was also a member of the Scottish Rite Valley of Fort Wayne.

Survivors include one son – Mickey (Pamela) Hefner of Huntington; two daughters – Vickie Randolph of North Webster and Josephine “Josi” (Phillip) Campbell of Warren; nine grandchildren and eleven great-grandchildren. His parents and brothers, Thomas Hefner and John Hefner Jr., preceded him in death.

There will be no visitation or funeral services. Burial will be in the Mt. Etna

Cemetery, Huntington County.
