



Richard F. "Dick" Riggle

September 16, 1923 - May 6, 2015

Richard F. "Dick" Riggle, age 91, of Huntington, passed away peacefully at home with family by his side on Wednesday (May 6, 2015) at 9:55 p.m.

Visitation will be from 10 a.m. - 12 p.m. Monday (May 11, 2015) at Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington. Funeral services will follow at 12 p.m. Monday (May 11, 2015) at Bailey-Love Mortuary with Pastor Jon Ritchie officiating. Burial will be in Gardens of Memory in Huntington County with military graveside rites performed by V.F.W. Post #2689 of Huntington.

Dick was born on September 16, 1923 in Huntington, the son of Herbert Arlo and Winifred (Avery) Riggle. He was a veteran of the United States Army, entering the service on January 16, 1943 and discharged on December 28, 1945. Dick married Mary E. Giddens on May 21, 1948 in Huntington.

He retired from Fisher Body in Marion on December 25, 1985 after 30 years of service as a production inspector. Dick was a member of First Presbyterian Church and served as a deacon. He was a member of the V.F.W Post #2689 in Huntington, where he was a devoted member of the color guard for many

years. Dick was also a member of the Sympathy Club at Fisher Body and the UAW Local #977 in Marion. He loved fishing and was an avid fan of both IU basketball and the Chicago Cubs.

Survivors include his wife of 66 years - Mary E. Riggle of Huntington; one son - Richard D. Riggle of Huntington; three daughters - Cathy Ann (Charles) Gard, Carla Jean (Dennis) Blocker, and Carol Davis, all of Huntington; one brother - Harold Riggle of Huntington; one sister - Jeanie Griffith of Leesburg, Indiana; seven grandchildren; seven great-grandchildren; and one great-great-granddaughter. He is preceded in death by his parents and brother, Robert T. Riggle.
