Robert "Bob" M. Seabolt, 77, of Warren, IN, passed away on Thursday, April 21, 2022, at his residence.

Bob was born on May 16, 1944, in Peru, IN, to Homer and Wilma (Kerschner) Seabolt. He attended Rock Creek High School and graduated with the class of 1963. He married the love of his life Roxanna Lea Smith on November 2, 1963, with whom he shared 58 years of cherished memories.

Bob started his career by working for the Railroad while in high school and after graduation he continued with a 20-year career as a Brakeman Conductor for Erie Lackawanna Railway.
