Robert Paul Heiney, 84, of Huntington, passed away at 3:30 pm Saturday, October 30, 2021 at his residence.

Robert was born on November 9, 1936 in Huntington, IN, the son of Fred Heiney and S. Marie (Draper) Heiney. He graduated from Huntington Township High School in 1954 and married Jean Ann Biehl on September 6, 1958 in Huntington. She preceded him in death on February 8, 2018. Robert grew up on the family farm and continued to farm in his adult years. He had joined the Carpenter's Union of Marion for a few years, then worked as a Construction worker for Marathon Construction building Kmart Stores. He continued his love for construction work and started his own family business, Heiney & Sons Construction with his sons. Later he sold the business to his sons and worked for Lawrence Construction before retiring from Swifty Oil after 10 years of service. Robert was a member of the St. Peter's First Community Church of Huntington and he was a short time member of the AA and was celebrating his 45th year of sobriety this year. He believed in hard work and using his hands was his way of life. He enjoyed logging and loved to restore antique tractors in his spare time.
