



## Robert W. "Sam" Hummer

December 22, 1925 - December 7, 2012

Robert W. "Sam" Hummer, age 86, of Huntington, died at 4:45 p.m. Friday (December 7, 2012) at his home.

The family will receive friends from 3 - 7 p.m. Wednesday (December 12, 2012) at Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington. Funeral services will be held at 10 a.m. Thursday (December 13, 2012) at the Evangelical United Methodist Church, 1000 Flaxmill Road, Huntington, with one hour of visitation prior to the services. The Rev. Dr. Marti Lundy will be officiating. Burial will take place at Gardens of Memory, Huntington County, with the V.F.W. Post #2689 performing military graveside rites.

Sam was born December 22, 1925 in Huntington, the son of Lulu Hummer. He graduated from Huntington High School in 1944. Sam was a veteran of the United States Navy serving in World War II. He married Martha Richardson on October 3, 1948 in Huntington.

Sam retired from Franklin Finance of Indiana in Huntington and, prior to that, he worked at Firstmark Financial for 30 years. Sam served as Huntington City

Councilman for over 19 years. He was a member of Evangelical United Methodist Church and enjoyed singing in the choir. Sam was a member, former Commander and a part of the Color Guard, for many years, with the V.F.W. Post #2689 of Huntington.

Survivors include his wife of 64 years - Martha Hummer of Huntington; one daughter - Jane A. (Steve) Bell of Huntington; one son - Bradley K. Hummer of Fort Wayne; four grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.
