Robert L. Miller, age 80, formerly of Huntington, died at 8:20 p.m. Tuesday (September 21, 2010) at the Visiting Nurse and Hospice Home in Ft. Wayne. He had resided in North Manchester for the past two and a half years.

Robert was born on November 26, 1929, in Union Township, Huntington County, the son of L. Russell and Irene E. (Eltzroth) Miller. He graduated from Chester Township High School in North Manchester in 1947. Robert served during the Korean War with the United States Army. On April 23, 1955, he married Virginia L. Brandenburg in North Manchester at the Congregational Christian Church.

Robert retired in 1993 as a receiving clerk for Sealtest/Kraft Foods after 37 years of service. Since then he worked for Owen's North Supermarket for 4 years. He was a member of the Central Christian Church in Huntington, a 50 year member of the Amity Masonic Lodge #483 F & AM and the Order of Eastern Star # 75 Floral Chapter where he served as Past Patron. Robert was also a member of the Scottish Rite of Fort Wayne and the Order of Eastern Star # 69 Ivy Chapter of North Manchester.

Survivors include his wife of 55 years – Virginia L. Miller of North Manchester; two sons – Brian D. (Katy) Miller of Hamilton and Brent D. Miller of Fort Wayne; two sisters – Norma D. (Richard) Williams of Fort Wayne and Shirley
