Robert Lee Neeley, age 80, of Huntington, died at 5 a.m. Thursday (May 5, 2011) at the home of his daughter.

Robert was born in Monument City, on January 10, 1931, the son of Richard D. and Edna Mae (Bollet) Neeley. He served in the United States Army during the Korean War. Robert married Betty L. Martz on February 14, 1954 in Fort Wayne. She preceded him in death on May 24, 1999.

Robert retired in 1986 from Fisher Body in Marion where he worked for over 30 years. He was a member of the Etna Avenue Wesleyan Church and the Veterans of Foreign Wars Post #2689 both in Huntington.
