



Robert R. "Bob" Scheerer

September 7, 1924 - January 20, 2014

Robert R. "Bob" Scheerer, age 89, of Huntington, died at 3:00 a.m. Monday (January 20, 2014) at Parkview Regional Medical Center in Fort Wayne.

Family will receive friends from 3 p.m. - 7 p.m. Friday (January 24, 2014) at Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington. Funeral services will be held at 10 a.m. Saturday (January 25, 2014) at Trinity United Methodist Church with one hour of visitation prior to the service. Rev. William Rapp will be officiating. Burial will be held in Mt. Hope Cemetery in Huntington with military graveside rites performed by the VFW Post #2689 in Huntington.

Robert was born September 7, 1924 in Union Township, the son of Edward and Bertha (Hosler) Scheerer. He graduated from Union Township in 1942. He served in the United States Navy during World War II as Fireman First Class. Robert married Edith Leona Hartley on June 27, 1947 in Huntington. He was the former owner of the Super Service Gas Station in Huntington for over ten years. He worked for the Erie Railroad as a tower operator for ten years. He also worked at the Meldisco Shoe Warehouse in Huntington for 14 years. He was a member of Trinity United Methodist Church, where he served as head

usher for over 25 years and served on many committees. He was a charter member of Metro Kiwanis, where he served as Secretary and Past President. He enjoyed woodworking, gardening, and photography.

Robert is survived by his wife of 66 years - Edith Scheerer of Huntington; one daughter - Nancy of Fort Wayne; and one granddaughter - Sarah Elizabeth of Fort Wayne. His parents, five brothers - Roy Scheerer, Russell Scheerer, Glenn Scheerer, Lester Scheerer, and Lewis Scheerer, and his sister - Matilda Bradburn precede him in death.
