Robert J. Schumaker, age 78, of Huntington, passed away at 1:55 p.m. Sunday (November 10, 2013) at Heritage of Huntington.

Graveside services will be held in Mt. Hope Cemetery in Huntington at 10:00 a.m. Wednesday, November 13, 2013 with Rev. Raymond Scribner officiating. Military graveside rites will be performed by VFW Post #2689 of Huntington.

Robert was born on July 27, 1935 in Bippus, the son of J. Earl and Gladys Mae (Wagner) Schumaker. He graduated from Chester Township High School in North Manchester in 1953 and he served as a corporal in the U.S. Army during the Korean War. He married M. Nadine Rudicel on March 18, 1985. She preceded him in death on October 23, 1999.

Robert retired from Conrail as a conductor after 33 years. He was a member of Amity Lodge 483 F & AM of Huntington. He was also a member of the Mizpah Temple in Fort Wayne and the Scottish Rite Valley also of Fort Wayne.

Robert is survived by two brothers - James E. Schumaker of Fort Wayne and Tom Schumaker of Highland Beach, FL; a stepson - Jack Rudicel of

Huntington; and seven step grandchildren. He is preceded in death by his parents, his wife, and a stepson - James Rudicel.
