Robert D. Stamper, age 87, of Huntington, died at 6:00 a.m. Sunday (January 8, 2012) at Miller's Merry Manor in Huntington.

Robert was born May 30, 1924, in Huntington, to Thomas B. and Estella (Hoopengarner) Stamper. He joined the United States Navy in August of 1941 and served in W.W. II. until November of 1945. Robert married Dorothy G. Cruea on April 6, 1947 in Delphi, Indiana.

Robert retired in 1984 from Haugk Plumbing & Heating, Decatur, working over 25 years. He was a member of the Plumber's and Steamfitter's Union Local #166, Fort Wayne and a lifetime member of the V.F.W. Post #2689 of Huntington. Robert enjoyed camping, fishing, and playing cards with family. He also liked to write and had several articles published in local papers.

Robert is survived by his wife of 64 years - Dorothy G. Stamper of Huntington; two sons - William C. "Bill" (Cyndi) Stamper of Burke, Virginia and James D. "Jim" (Kathryn) Stamper of Fort Wayne; one daughter - Karla A. Funk of Huntington; one sister - Ruth (Charles) Schreiber of Cottonwood, Arizona; and two grandchildren - Christina J. Stamper of Burke, Virginia and Adam (Amanda) Seeger of Keller, Texas. His parents, brothers - John Stamper and Gilbert Stamper, and sisters - Alice Steele and Rosalyn Jones preceded him in death.
