



Robert D. "Stoney" Stonebraker

July 31, 1927 - July 17, 2018

Robert D. "Stoney" Stonebraker, age 90, of Huntington, died at 1:00 p.m. Tuesday, July 17, 2018 at Heritage Pointe of Huntington.

Visitation will be from 1 - 3 p.m. Wednesday, July 25, 2018 at Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington, Indiana. Funeral services will immediately follow at 3 p.m. Wednesday at Bailey-Love Mortuary with Pastor Randy DeBois officiating. Burial will be in Gardens of Memory in Huntington County at a later date.

Robert was born on July 31, 1927 in Huntington, the son of Dale M. and Mary (Stetzel) Stonebraker. He graduated from Huntington High School in 1946 and served in the United States Army Air Corps, Private First Class, as a mechanic during World War II. He married Catherine Luella Sparks on April 10, 1948 in Huntington. Robert retired as a journeyman electrician for A. Hattersley & Sons in Fort Wayne and was a member of First Baptist Church in Huntington for 80 years. He lived in Huntington until his retirement; then he moved to the home he built on Sechrist Lake. In 2003, he moved back to Huntington to be closer to his family. Over his lifetime, he enjoyed racing stock

cars, fishing, traveling, genealogy, and spending time with family.

Survivors include his wife of 70 years, Catherine L. Stonebraker of Huntington, a son, Gary Stonebraker of Coldwater, Michigan, a daughter, Linda Couch (fiancée Thomas Bridge) of Huntington, brothers Keith Stonebraker of Fort Wayne, Dean Stonebraker of Huntington, Arthur (Carol) Stonebraker of Kokomo, Neil (Sandy) Stonebraker of Huntington, and James Stonebraker of Roanoke, a sister, Norma (Rex) Jones of Roanoke, grandsons Troy (Carrie) Couch, Brad (Leigh Anne) Couch, and Adam (Candice) Couch, all of Huntington, great grandchildren Tory, Wyatt, Chloe, Libby, Dalton, and Jason Couch, and many nieces and nephews who lovingly called him “Uncle Bob.” He is preceded in death by his parents, a grandson, Ryan Couch, a sister, Lois Offutt, a brother, Richard Stonebraker, and a son-in-law, Gary Couch.

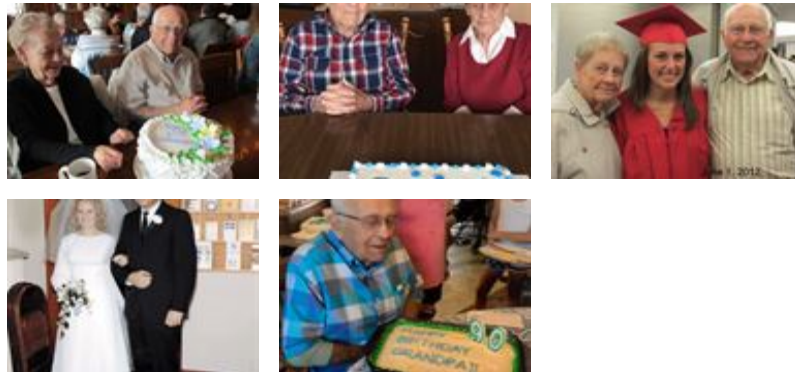
