November 28, 1923 - September 16, 2009

Robert A. Lowery, age 85, of Huntington, died at 7:26 p.m. Wednesday (September 16, 2009) at St. Joseph Hospital in Ft. Wayne.

Robert was born on November 28, 1923 in Griggs, Oklahoma to Ernest S. and Ethel L. (Abbott) Lowery. He graduated from Rock Creek Township High School in 1942. He then joined the Army Air Corps and served as a Sergeant in World War II. Robert married Earline J. Dolby on December 22, 1946 at the Pleasant Grove Church.

Robert was a farmer in Rock Creek Township for 55 years and was a member of the Pleasant Grove United Methodist Church.

Survivors include his wife, Earline J. Lowery, of 62 years; one son – Galen (Lee Ann) Lowery of Milford, Michigan; two daughters – Carol M. Humphreys of Arvada, Colorado, and Karen J. (Lou) Nagel of Cheyenne, Wyoming; one sister – Maro (Gene) Whinery of Warren; four grandchildren, one great-grandson, three step grandchildren and three step great-grandchildren. His parents; one son – Daryl Lee Lowery; three brothers – Marshall Lowery, G.W. Lowery and Ernest Lowery, Jr.; and three sisters – Helen Wilson, Naomi Lowery, and Alma Lowery precede him in death.
