



Ronald Eugene "Ron" Horrell

March 19, 1944 - May 6, 2020

Ronald Eugene "Ron" Horrell, age 76, of Huntington, died at 8:15 a.m. Wednesday, May 6, 2020 at Parkview Wabash Hospital.

Private graveside services will be held in the Masonic Cemetery in Warren with Pastor Jason Parsons officiating. A gathering of family and friends will be from 2 – 6 p.m. Friday, May 8, 2020 at Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington, Indiana.

Ron was born on March 19, 1944 in Huntington, the son of James W. and Corinne C. (Kitt) Horrell. He was a 1962 graduate of Clear Creek High School and he married Sue Ann Allen on November 27, 1966 in Warren. He was a farmer, a crop insurance adjuster, sold crop insurance, and worked at Transwheel Corporation for 25 years. Ron was a member of Faith Chapel United Methodist Church in Huntington and spent many years as a trustee. He served in the Army National Guard and was an avid Indiana University basketball fan. He was a member of the 4-H Fair Board for many years. He loved to be outside, raise hogs, and be on tractors. Ron loved spending time with Sue and family, helping others, attending the 4-H Fair, and supporting his

kids and grandkids in all that they did. He received the best gift ever from Sue, her kidney, in 1993. He is forever loved and will be missed.

Survivors include his wife, Sue Horrell of Huntington, daughters Tammy L. (Darrell) Poulson and Julie A. (Adam) Hendryx, both of Huntington, a sister, Janice Bolin of Warsaw, and a sister-in-law, Billie Horrell of Warren. Also surviving are grandchildren Jordyn Poulson, Jenna Poulson, Madison Poulson, Mara Hendryx, and Haden Hendryx. He is preceded in death by his parents and a brother, Roger Horrell.

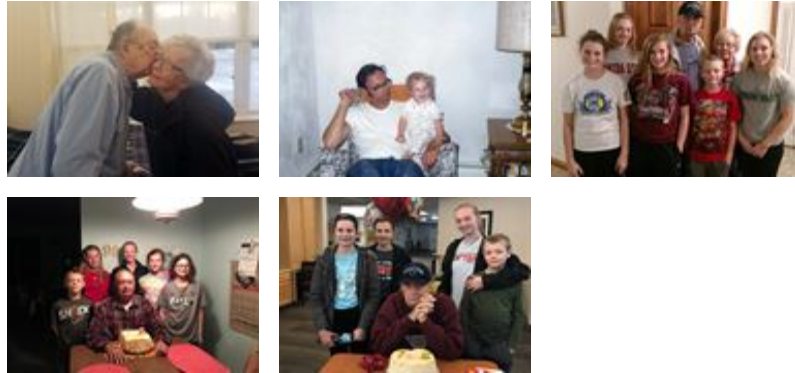
