Ronald G. "Ron" Kistler, age 76, of Huntington, died at 3:00 a.m. Friday, August 30, 2019 at Parkview Regional Medical Center in Ft. Wayne.

A memorial service with military memorial honors will be held at VFW Post #2689 of Huntington at a later date.

Ron was born on March 31, 1943 in Marion, the son of Arthur and Garnet (Burman) Kistler. He graduated from Huntington High School in 1961 and served in the United States Marines. He married Joyce Ann Williams on August 1, 1970 in Zanesville; she preceded him in death on August 22, 2009. Ron retired from Memcor in Huntington.

Survivors include sons Paul E. (Marie) Kistler and Travis G. Kistler, both of Huntington, Donald G. Kistler of Fort Wayne, and Jason Kistler of Kendallville, a daughter, Farah A. (John) Bess of Huntington, 13 grandchildren, and five great grandchildren. His parents and wife precede him in death.
