August 13, 1950 - January 21, 2022

Ronald DeWaine Tarr, 71, of Cabot succumbed to his illness on January 21, 2022, after a sudden heart event on Christmas Eve 2021. He was born August 13, 1950, in Fort Wayne, Indiana, to the late Susanne Maurine and Roger Eugene Tarr. In addition to his parents, Ronald was preceded in death by his eldest son, Joseph Tarr.

He married his wife of fifty-two years, Twyla Jean Tarr, on December 13, 1969. After weeks of a loving witness to God's saving grace was shown by his friend, Fred, Ronald accepted Jesus Christ as his Saviour and was born again in his living room on December 18, 1978. Ronald then began to attend Waynedale Baptist Church. Following His Lord's lead, he became assistant pastor at Roanoke Baptist Church in Indiana for thirteen years.
