



## Ronald W. "Ron" Amick

Ronald W. "Ron" Amick, age 59, of Huntington, died at 3:17 p.m. on Thursday (November 5, 2009) at Parkview Huntington Hospital.

Ron was born on January 18, 1950 in Huntington, the son of George and Lucille (Teusch) Amick. Ron married Deborah Nowels on December 26, 1981 in Huntington.

Ron was employed with Huntington Community School Corporation for 13 Years as an Electrician. Prior to that, he was employed as a Maintenance Supervisor at Majestic Corporation in Huntington. Ron was also a self employed contractor. He attended St. Peter and Paul Catholic Church.

Survivors include his wife 27 years – Deborah Nowels of Huntington; two sons – Rye N. Amick of Huntington, and Colin N. Amick of Fort Wayne; one daughter – Claire N. Amick of Huntington; one brother – George Amick of Huntington; and three sisters – Judy (Jim) Rosen of Andrews, Kathy (Terry) Denton of Huntington, and Debbie (Mike) Pace of Brighton, Michigan.
