She is survived by her brother - James "Jim" Fowler of Silver Lake. Her parents and her husband precede her in death.

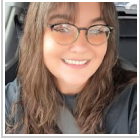

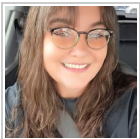

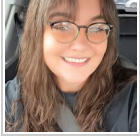

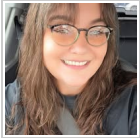
