Ruby P. Stouder Graham, age 85, died at 7:30 a.m. Tuesday (January 13, 2009) at the home of her son.

Ruby retired in 1972 from the Army Surplus Store where she had worked as a clerk. Prior to that, she worked at the One Hour Martinizing in Huntington. She was a member of Central Christian Church.
