



## Russell Caley Jr.

November 18, 1925 - August 30, 2015

Russell Caley Jr., age 89, of Huntington, died at 8:32 p.m. Sunday (August 30, 2015) at his home.

Visitation will be from 3 - 7 p.m. Wednesday (September 2, 2015) at Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington, Indiana. Funeral services will be held at 11 a.m. Thursday (September 3, 2015) at Bailey-Love Mortuary with Chaplain Forrest Tabor officiating. There will be one hour of visitation prior to the service. Burial will be in Sparks Cemetery in Markle.

Russell was born on November 18, 1925 in Huntington, the son of Russell Sr. and Lydia (Kahlenbeck) Caley. He married Ada L. Miller on April 6, 1947 in Huntington, and she preceded him in death on October 27, 2010. Russell delivered milk for Rosehill Dairy in Bluffton and worked at Caswell Runyon in Huntington. He retired in 1996 after several years as a forklift driver at Kresges Warehouse in Fort Wayne. He worked for the Darl and Steve Platt family, farming in Huntington and Allen Counties for several years. He was a member of St. Peter's First Community Church in Huntington and loved working in the yard, fishing, and family vehicles.

Survivors include two daughters - Carolyn Craig and Kathy (John) Myers, both of Huntington; a sister - Bonnie Hahn of Andrews; three grandchildren - Michele Myers, Joseph Myers, and Jason Craig; and five great grandchildren - Skylar Myers, Evelyn Myers, Cale Craig, Laura Craig, and Gregory Myers. His parents, his wife, a daughter - Vickie Diann Caley, and a brother - Wayne Caley, precede him in death.
