



## Sandra E. Wohlford Wiley

April 2, 1944 - October 13, 2016

Sandra E. Wohlford Wiley, age 72, of Roanoke, died at 5:26 a.m. Thursday, October 13, 2016 at Oakbrook Village in Huntington.

Visitation will be from 3 - 4 p.m. Tuesday, October 18, 2016 at Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington, Indiana. Funeral services will immediately follow at 4 p.m. Tuesday, at Bailey-Love Mortuary. Burial will be in Glenwood Cemetery in Roanoke.

Sandra was born on April 2, 1944 in Roanoke, the daughter of Walter V. and Grace (Christ) Wohlford. After graduating from Roanoke High School in 1962, she earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in journalism from Indiana University, Fort Wayne. She worked on the editorial staff at USA Today (Florida edition). She also worked on the editorial staff in Columbia City, where she received a special award for her articles on Whitko High School in their run for a state championship. Later, she served on the editorial staff at the Huntington Herald Press as a news writer and reporter. She also served as the editor for the Indiana Appaloosa Horse Association. She and her sons competed in many horse shows and won several riding awards. Sandra proved to be a real fighter, as she returned to work at the Herald-Bulletin following a major heart

attack. Two disabling strokes however, allowed her to return with her son Ronald's help to her home on Posey Hill Street in Roanoke, next door to the home where she was born and lived as a child.

Survivors include a son - Ronald Wiley of Roanoke; two brothers - Stephen (Mary Ann) Wohlford of Noblesville and Paul (Shirley) Wohlford of Anderson; a sister - Carolyn Bansbach of Lakeland, Florida; four grandchildren, and five great grandchildren. She is preceded in death by her parents, a son, Paul Wiley, three brothers, Charles Wohlford, Harold Wohlford, and Max Wohlford, a sister, Martha Jean Mauman.
