Shawn M. Taylor, age 40, of Huntington, died at 10:23 a.m. on Monday, June 24, 2019 at his home.

Visitation will be from 1 – 5 p.m. Sunday, June 30, 2019 at Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington, Indiana. Funeral services will be held at 11 a.m. Monday, July 1, 2019 at Bailey-Love Mortuary with Pastor Matt Snodderly officiating. There will be one hour of visitation prior to the service. 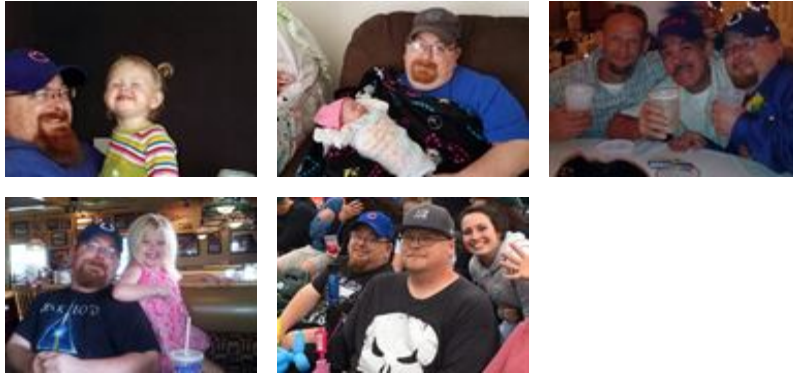

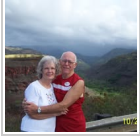

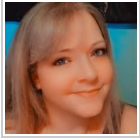
