Sheridan G. Falcone, 60, of Fort Wayne, died at 3:12 am Tuesday, October 13, 2020 at his Residence.

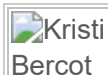

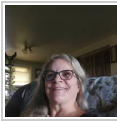

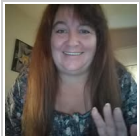
