Spencer D. Beals, age 70, of Huntington, died at 2:04 a.m. Tuesday, March 7, 2017 at Parkview Huntington Hospital with his family surrounding him with their love.

Visitation will be from 1 - 4 p.m. Sunday, March 12, 2017 at Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington, Indiana. Funeral services will be held at 11 a.m. Monday, March 13, 2017 at Bailey-Love Mortuary with Rev. Steven McPeek officiating. There will be one hour of visitation prior to the service. Burial will be in Marion National Cemetery with military graveside rites performed by VFW Post #2689 of Huntington.

Spencer was born September 7, 1946 in Beloit, Wisconsin, the son of Duane A. and Grace M. (Napper) Beals. He graduated from Clinton High School in Clinton, Wisconsin in 1964 and served in the United States Air Force as a Sergeant during the Vietnam War. He was a forklift driver at General Motors in Fort Wayne and a member of VFW Post #2689 and American Legion Post #85, both in Huntington. Spencer loved woodworking, cooking, and caring for his rose garden; he also enjoyed bowling. He was a fan of the Green Bay Packers and Wisconsin Badgers. He had a heart of gold, an open door policy,

and never turned a stranger away.

Survivors include two daughters - Angela M. Elick of Columbia City and Heather L. Easterday of Huntington; three sisters - Donna McFarlin of Clinton, Wisconsin, Kathy A. 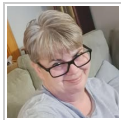

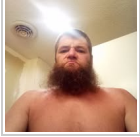
