Stanley Howard Landrum, age 71, of Huntington, died at 6:55 a.m. Wednesday (May 13, 2015) at Norwood Health and Rehabilitation in Huntington.

Burial will be at 10 a.m. Friday (May 15, 2015) in Mt. Etna Cemetery in Huntington County, with military graveside rites preformed by VFW Post #2689 of Huntington.

Stan was born on February 16, 1944 in Huntington County, the son of Harvey Leroy and Nellie (Rinearson) Landrum.
