June 30, 1953 - July 21, 2019

Stanley W. Meyer, age 66, of Huntington, died at 11:59 a.m. on Sunday, July 21, 2019 at his home.

There will be no visitation or funeral services. At a later date, his remains will be spread by his skydiving friends honoring him in his “final jump.”

Stanley was born on June 30, 1953 in Huntington, the son of Kenneth and Mary (Driscoll) Meyer. He was a 1971 graduate of Huntington Catholic High School and worked in production at Breyers for 32 years, retiring in 2012. He was an avid skydiver with over 3,500 jumps and was a member of U.S. Skydiving Association. He was a BASE jumper and also enjoyed rock climbing and repelling – he was a thrill seeker. His most recent adventure was watching his grandchildren grow up; they were a huge part of his life.

Survivors include a daughter, Carly C. (Brady) Bailey of Warren, his ex-wife, Anne Powers of Huntington, brothers Alan (Leticia) Meyer of Fort Wayne and Denny (Margaret) Meyer of North Webster, sisters Diane (Mark) Smith of Verona, Wisconsin and Cindy (Bob) McKay of Huntington, and grandchildren Kennady Chapin, Kyler Chapin, and Dax Bailey. His parents precede him in death.

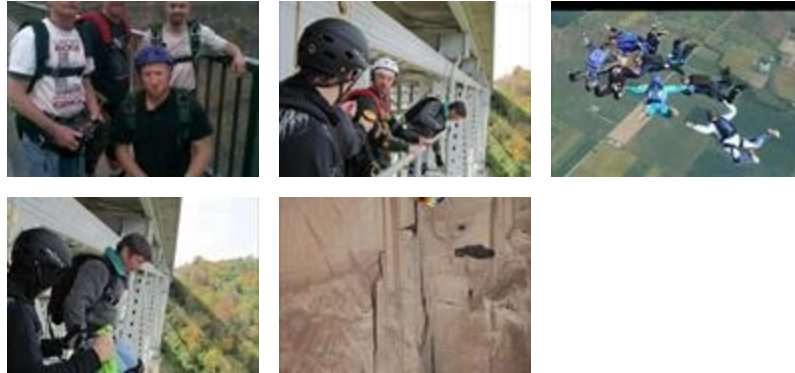
