Steven J. Fulton, age 76, of Huntington, died Wednesday, April 8, 2020 at his home.

Private graveside services will be held in Lancaster Cemetery in Huntington County.

Steve was born on October 22, 1943 in Huntington, the son of William J. and Marjorie M. (Kline) Fulton. He graduated from Lancaster Township High School in 1961 and married Barbara Ellen Thomas on September 11, 1965 in Warren; she preceded him in death on December 16, 2013. Steve worked in carpentry and was a lifetime farmer in Lancaster Township. He served as the sexton of Lancaster Cemetery and was a member of Salamonie Church of the Brethren and Huntington Lions Club. He was Past-President of the Huntington County 4-H Fair Association and an avid Huntington University basketball fan. He enjoyed mowing and loved spending time with his family and friends.

Survivors include sons Thomas J. (Jennifer Goff) Fulton and Richard A. Fulton, both of Huntington, a brother, Walter Fulton of Andrews, and a sister, Marilyn (Charles) Stucker of Ossian. Also surviving are grandchildren Mariah

N. Fulton and Gregory M. Goff and three great grandchildren. His parents and his wife precede him in death.
