Steven Max Zeissig, age 70, of Huntington, died at 9:45 p.m. Friday, February 21, 2020 at Parkview Regional Medical Center in Fort Wayne.

Visitation will be from 3 – 7 p.m. Wednesday, February 26, 2020 at Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington, Indiana. Funeral services will be held at 10 a.m. Thursday, February 27, 2020 at Bailey-Love Mortuary with Rev. Zen Hess officiating. There will be one hour of visitation prior to the service. 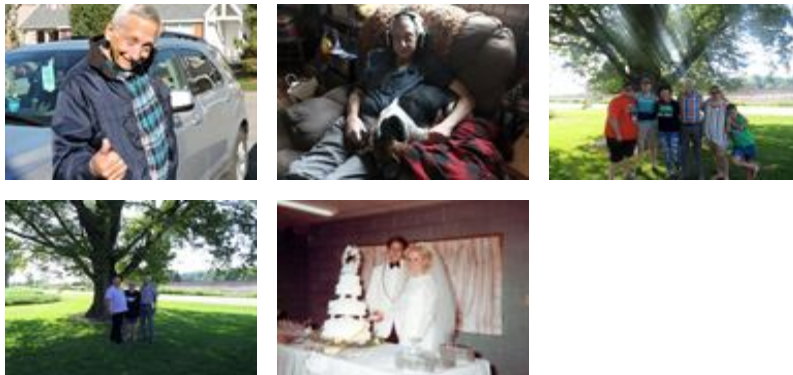
