Terese "Teri" Marie Shiflett, 68, of Huntington, IN, passed away peacefully after a courageous battle with cancer in the company of her family at 3:20 am Wednesday, November 22, 2023, at her residence.

She graduated from Jupiter Junior Senior High School with the class of 1972 and continued her education at Oklahoma State University where she studied sign language and became an interpreter.
