



Thais R. Wilhelm

December 19, 1929 - September 9, 2017

Thais R. Wilhelm, age 87, of Huntington, died at 4:50 a.m. Saturday, September 9, 2017 at Tipton Place in Huntington.

Visitation will be from 12 - 4 p.m. on Saturday, September 16, 2017 at Central Christian Church, 500 MacGahan Street, Huntington, Indiana. Funeral services will immediately follow at 4 p.m. Saturday, September 16, 2017 at Central Christian Church with Pastor Chris Hayden officiating. Burial will be in Mt. Etna Cemetery in Huntington County.

Preferred memorials are to Central Christian Church, in care of Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington, Indiana, 46750.

Thais was born on December 19, 1929 in Huntington, the daughter of Homer and Leila (Getz) Carl, Sr. She graduated from Huntington High School in 1947 and married Ivan E. Wilhelm on June 19, 1949 at Central Christian Church in Huntington. Thais worked at Huntington License Branch and served as both Huntington County Assessor and Huntington Township Assessor. She retired from the Huntington County Sheriff's Department after 36 years of service. She was the first elected female Sheriff in the State of Indiana, holding the office for ten years. Thais was an active lifetime member of Central Christian Church. For 50 years, she was a member of Child Welfare Club in Huntington. She served on the board of directors for Salvation Army, Youth Services

Bureau, REMC, and ABWA of Huntington County. She especially loved to spend time with her family, service the community, and play bridge.

Survivors include her husband of 68 years - Ivan E. Wilhelm of Huntington; three daughters - Leslie (Allen) Myers of Fishers, Jennifer (Ken) Koch of North Royalton, Ohio, and Lisa (Rick) Fusselman of Huntington; two sisters - Janice Eller of Mentone and Catherine Stayner of Huntington; eight grandchildren, and twelve great grandchildren. She is preceded in death by her parents, a daughter, Elizabeth Ann Wilhelm, two brothers, Homer Carl Jr. and J.C. Carl, and a sister, Phyllis Ziegler.

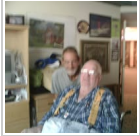
