



## Thomas E. Elick

July 13, 1946 - March 9, 2010

Thomas E. Elick, age 63, of Huntington, died at 11:30 p.m. Tuesday (March 9, 2010) at his home.

Thomas was born on July 13, 1946 in Huntington to Eugene and Vivian (Goodwin) Elick. He graduated from Huntington North High School and went on to join the United States Army. Thomas married Jackie Snow on December 19, 2008 and she survives.

Thomas was a retired engineer for the Norfolk and Southern Railroad, Erie Railroad and Conrail after 32 years of service. He was a former First Vice with the American Legion Post #85, a member of the Am Vets of Fort Wayne Post #0055, and a member of the Moose Lodge #837.
