Thomas Joseph Good, age 77, of North Manchester, formerly of Warren, died at 7:08 p.m. Tuesday (May 27, 2014) at Lutheran Hospital in Fort Wayne.

He retired in 1992 from Crestview Middle School after serving as a custodian for seven years. He was a member of Warren Area Kiwanis Club and Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia at Ball State University.

Thomas is survived by his sister - Cynthia Ann French; two nieces - Catherine French of Indianapolis and Amy Robbins of Carmel; and two nephews - Jeffrey French of Fort Wayne and Stephan French of Rochester. His parents and his wife precede him in death.
