Thomas J. Mullis, age 72, of Huntington, died Friday at 5:38 a.m. (May 24, 2013) at Lutheran Hospital.

Visitation will be from 1 - 4 p.m. Sunday (May 26, 2013) at Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington. Funeral services will be 10 a.m. Monday (May 27, 2013) at Bailey-Love Mortuary with military rites performed by the V.F.W. Post #2689. There will be no burial.
