Tim L. McCune, 61, of Huntington, passed away peacefully at 12:17 am Tuesday, August 5, 2025, surrounded by his family at home after a tough battle with ALS.

Tim was born on May 26, 1964, in Huntington, IN, the son of Joyce McCune and Betty (Carroll) McCune. He graduated from Huntington North High School Class of 1982 and married Susan Carr Seabolt on August 30, 2014, in Gatlinburg, TN. Tim learned about hard work from a young age. 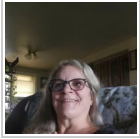
Tim is preceded in death by his Father, Joyce G. McCune and First Wife of 30 years, Dwan M. McCune.
