



## Timothy "Tim" W. Kimmel

Timothy "Tim" W. Kimmel, 68, of Fort Wayne, formerly of Huntington, passed away at 5:33 am Wednesday, May 25, 2022 at Majestic Care.

Tim was born on January 9, 1954 in Huntington, IN, the son of Daniel J. Kimmel and Carol V. (Morris) Kimmel.
