



## Trent R. Tallman

October 18, 1957 - August 31, 2011

Trent R. Tallman, age 53, of Huntington, died at 12:45 a.m. Wednesday (August 31, 2011) at Lutheran Hospital in Fort Wayne.

Trent was born October 18, 1957, in Huntington, to William R. and Jean (Young) Tallman. He was a 1976 graduate of Huntington North High School and attended IPFW in Fort Wayne. Trent married Dianne J. Hillyard on October 21, 1978, in Fort Wayne.

Trent worked for CME Corporation in Fort Wayne as a Project Manager/Estimator for 6 years.

Trent is survived by his wife of 32 years - Dianne J. Tallman of Huntington; his mother and stepfather - Jean (William R.) Florent of Huntington; two sons - Christopher R. Tallman of Roanoke and Scott D. Tallman of Indianapolis; one daughter - Amanda K. Tallman of Huntington; his brother - Thomas W. Tallman of Huntington; and two grandchildren - Elisabeth M. Tallman and Lucas R. Tallman both of Roanoke. His father preceded him in death.

Visitation will be from 3 - 7 p.m. Friday (September 2, 2011) at Bailey-Love Mortuary. Funeral Services will be at 10 a.m. Saturday (September 3, 2011) at Bailey-Love Mortuary with 1 hour of visitation prior to service. Rev. Raymond Scribner will be officiating.
