Treva S. Douglas, 93, of Ossian, IN and formerly of Warren, IN, passed away at 9:49 am Sunday, November 9, 2025, at Ossian Health and Rehab Center.

Treva was born on February 9, 1932, in Montpelier, IN, the daughter of Charles Morris and Mary (Murphy) Morris. Growing up in a large family she was always surrounded by love and laughter. She graduated from Huntington High School with the class of 1950. Later in the fall Treva married the love of her life Richard W. Douglas on November 10, 1950. They were blessed with three girls and shared forty-four years of marriage before he preceded her in death on April 4, 1995.

Treva demonstrated remarkable athletic talent from a young age. At just 16 years old, she earned her place on the girls' softball championship team, showcasing her skill and dedication to the sport. Her competitive spirit wasn't limited to softball; that same year, Treva achieved an extraordinary feat by winning the City Championship in tennis, badminton, and ping pong. Treva never lost her love for sports as she grew older. She kept playing softball, staying connected to the game that meant so much to her. Later, she found a new interest in bowling and once more she excelled, earning a place at state.

Treva was known for her strong work ethic and her desire to help others in her community. She was active in the Wesleyan Nazarene Church, Craft Club,

and Big & Little Sister Club, always giving her time to support and connect with others. Treva worked at Huntington Electric for ten years, Memcor for twenty-five years, and Bertsch Vending for five years. She finished her career working ten more years at the BMV offices in Warren and Huntington. Treva retired at the age of 70, showing her dedication throughout her life. With decades of hard work and kindness, Treva left a lasting impression on her family, friends, and community. Her generosity and commitment will always be remembered
