Verne L. Endsley, age 91, 1432 Walnut Street, Huntington, died at 3:20 p.m. Wednesday (January 7, 2009) at Parkview Huntington Hospital.

Mr. Endsley retired from H. K. Porter in Huntington where he worked for over 30 years. He had worked prior for the Coil Engineering in Roanoke for over 12 years and was a farm hand. He was a member of the Zion United Methodist Church, and the Huntington County Farm Bureau for over 64 years.

Verne was born on May 25, 1917 in Howard County, to Otho L. and Mary Isabelle Lindley Endsley. On May 19, 1946, he married Betty Jane Chenoweth in Huntington County.
