Virginia R. Walker, age 101, of Huntington, died at 8:19 a.m. Friday, July 8, 2016 at Heritage Pointe in Warren.

Virginia was born on October 12, 1914 in Grant County, Indiana, the daughter of Claude J. and Carol (Flinn) Ancil. She graduated from Sweetser High School in 1932 and was a graduate of Marion Business College. She married Walter D. Walker on August 18, 1946 in Grant County; he preceded her in death on May 18, 2003. Virginia was a homemaker for 63 years on the farm in Lancaster Township. Prior to her marriage she worked as a secretary at the Osborne Paper Company for 14 years. She was a member of First Church of the Nazarene in Huntington, where she loved to sing in the choir and was a member of the band for 42 years; she also enjoyed gardening.

Survivors include a son - Dennis M. (Renee) Walker of West Chester, Ohio; three daughters - Marsha (John) Updike of Huntington, Camille (James) Cross of Kendallville, and Donna Wimmer of Greenwood; ten grandchildren, 14 great grandchildren, six nieces, and three nephews. She is preceded in death by her parents, husband, two brothers, John Ancil and Bernard Ancil, and a granddaughter, Shelly Cross.
