Virginia "Ginny" Weinley, age 97, of Huntington, died at 4:39 a.m. Friday, January 10, 2020 at Heritage Pointe of Huntington.

Visitation will be from 3 – 7 p.m. Monday, January 20, 2020 at Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington, Indiana. Rosary services will be held at 2:45 p.m. Monday prior to visitation. A Mass of Christian Burial will at 10 a.m. Tuesday, January 21, 2020 at SS Peter and Paul Catholic Church, 860 Cherry Street, Huntington, Indiana, with Father Steve Colchin officiating. There will be one hour of visitation at the church prior to the service. Burial will be in Mt. Calvary Cemetery in Huntington.

Weinley on October 17, 1953 in Huntington; he preceded her in death on February 14, 1985. Ginny owned and operated Virginia's Beauty Shop for over 60 years. She also taught at Yuma State Beauty College in Arizona. She was a member of SS

Peter and Paul Catholic Church in Huntington, where she served as head of the rosary sodality. She was a member of the Daughters of Isabella and was a past President of Kappa Sigma Tau Sorority. Ginny enjoyed fishing and loved spending summers in Michigan's Upper Peninsula.

She is survived by a daughter, Mary Catherine Flora of Canton, Michigan, granddaughters Jill (Eddie) Jones and Jennifer (Mike) Shull, a grandson, Jeffery (Natalie) Flora and great grandchildren Jack Shull, Luke Shull, Cole Flora, and Maisyn Flora. 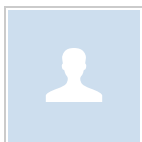
