



Vivian Irene Hanson

June 15, 1920 - April 10, 2011

Vivian Irene Hanson, age 90, of Huntington, died at 12:50 a.m. Sunday (April 10, 2011) at her home.

Vivian was born on June 15, 1920, in LaPorte, Indiana, the daughter of Alta and Lottie “Happy” (Francher) Wright. She was a 1947 graduate of Idaville High School and went on to graduate from Warner’s Beauty College. On July 15, 1947, Vivian married Henry “Hank” Hanson in Fort Wayne, Indiana and he survives.

Vivian was the owner of Vivian’s Beauty Salon in Huntington and past co-owner, along with her husband, of Hank’s Disposal Service in Huntington. She was a member of the Order of the Eastern Star, Huntington Chapter, The Women’s Ministry of Sweetwater Assembly of God Church in North Manchester, and an honorary member of The Chief LaFontaine Saddle Club in Huntington.

Survivors include her husband of 63 years - Henry “Hank” Hanson of Huntington; one son - Terry (Katy) Hanson of Greenfield, Ohio; one daughter - Daralene (Dick) Bowman of Huntington; seven grandchildren - Shantiel (Bowman) Fulton of Huntington, Bart (Heather) Hanson of Greenfield, Ohio, Aaraka (Tommy) Case of Lagro, Racquel (Nate) Mills of Huntington, Danielle (Chris) Line of Huntington, Andrea (Brandon) Haselby of Monticello, and
