Wallace L. Bowers, Sr., age 67, of Huntington, passed at 8:56 a.m. Saturday (October 22, 2011) at Norwood Health & Rehabilitation in Huntington.

Wallace was born March 1, 1944, in Union Township, Huntington County, the son of Burl L. and Dorothy (Burns) Bowers. On July 10, 1970, he was united in marriage to Gloria Sue Williams in Huntington.
