



## Wallace D. Boyd

December 29, 1929 - January 25, 2010

Wallace D. Boyd, age 80, formerly of Huntington, died at 8:35 p.m. Monday (January 25, 2010) at Heritage Pointe in Warren.

Wallace was born December 29, 1929 in Huntington to Eldon and Mary Helen (Lee) Boyd. He graduated from Huntington High School in 1947. He later joined the United States Army serving in the Korean War as a Corporal. Wallace married Betty Morris on December 30, 1951 in Huntington. She preceded him in death on July 4, 1987.

Wallace retired from the Huntington Post Office on August 1, 1985 where he worked for 28 years. He was a member of the former St. Peter's First United Church of Christ in Huntington.

Survivors include one son – Mark D. (Kimberly) Boyd of Huntington; two daughters – Penny (Duane) Sunderman of Huntington and Amy (James) Johnson of Huntington; six grandchildren and one great-grandchild. Besides his parents and his wife, a brother - Edward Boyd, preceded him in death.

Visitation will be from 2 - 8 p.m. Thursday (January 28, 2010) at Bailey-Love Mortuary. The funeral service will then be held at 10 a.m. Friday (January 29, 2010) at Bailey-Love Mortuary with Rev.
