January 2, 1929 - December 26, 2010

Wayne D. Caley, Sr., age 81, of Huntington, died at 10:28 a.m. Sunday (December 26, 2010) at Parkview Huntington Hospital.

Wayne was born January 2, 1929, the son of Russell A. and Lydia (Kalenbeck) Caley, Sr., in Huntington. He was a 1948 graduate of Monument City High School and a veteran of the United States Army. On October 22, 1950, Wayne married Nannette Satterthwaite in Wabash County.

Wayne retired in 1994 from Fisher Body in Marion after 25 years of service. He was also a lifetime Polk Township farmer. Wayne was a member of St. Peter's Evangelical Lutheran Church and the Sympathy Club at Fisher Body.
